INSTRUCTIONS & RULES

1. All goats must be free of contagious and infectious diseases. Animals found to have or to be developing symptoms of diseases may be sent home by the Superintendent or the Fair. Health papers for TB and Brucellosis are needed.
2. All animals must be owned by the exhibitor prior to 6/1/09
3. Each exhibitor is limited to two entries per class.
4. Goats shown in specialty classes must have been shown in single classes.
5. Only exhibitors and Fair employees are allowed to work on the goats at the Fairgrounds.
6. **RABIES SHOTS** are recommended.
7. **Bedding will not be provided.**

GOAT FITTING & SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST

Saturday, September 5, 2009 at 1:00 PM

All goat exhibitors must participate in Fitting & Showmanship. Failure to participate will result in forfeit of all goat prizes.

Exhibitors are limited to showing one goat in this contest, and this animal must be shown in a single class. Showmanship will count 50%, and Fitting of the animal 50%.

The following uniforms are to be worn when showing goats:

Girls - white blouses, khaki or white slacks, skirts or shorts

Boys - white or 4-H or FFA "Tee" shirts, khaki pants or shorts

DEPT. 6X

1. Advance - For exhibitors over 14 years old who have previously won 1st place in a senior showmanship contest.
2. Senior - For exhibitors 14 through 19 years of age 1/1/08 who have shown animals previously.
3. Junior - For exhibitors 9 through 13 years of age 1/1/08 who have shown animals previously.
4. Novice - For all exhibitors who have not show their goat prior to this year.

Champion Showman - The first award winners in classes 1, 2, 3, 4 in Dept. 6X will compete for Champion Showman. Awards will be rosettes as follows Champion (blue); Reserve Champion (red); Honorable Mention (white); Fourth (yellow).

All exhibitors will be entered for the Herdsman Award. Judging will be based upon keeping the animals and general area neat, clean and attractive, and upon the attitude and cooperation of exhibitors.

A written knowledge quiz based upon the bulletin, "Dairy Goats - Breeding/Feeding/Management" will be available to all exhibitors.
